

## Islamic Finance Qualification

### Dates

**Examination:** The first computer based examination (CBT - Computer Based Testing) was held on the **19th of March 2007**

The IFQ went live on CBT, 19 March 2007 and is therefore available to book on CBT. Below you will find the relevant section from the SII website on the CBT schedule:

#### **What choice of date and time do I have?**

Subject to availability, you can take your test on any date that you choose, within the opening hours of each test centre. When you select a date, you will be presented with the next available appointment on or after that date. You can choose between a morning or afternoon tests. Our flagship test centre in the City of London is open from 08.00 until 18.00 daily, Monday to Friday. Some test centres are also open for part of the day on Saturday. Some centres do not offer availability in the middle of the day.

Closing Date: 48 hrs before examination (subject to availability)
